

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Truly dedicated American citizenship in our proud State is expressed through each individual's constant devotion to the fulfillment and safeguarding of our inured freedom, and readiness to defend our nation against all enemies, whatsoever; and

WHEREAS, The patriotic unity of our people is today challenged by un-American influences seeking to unify and to destroy freedom around the world; and

WHEREAS, Such threats to the American way of life can best be counteracted through the continuing patriotic reaffirmation of all truly loyal citizens who stand united in the firm defense of our ideals and nation, at all times and throughout every state of the Union;

Now therefore, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby decree with the Congress and the President of the United States in designating the first day of May as

"LOYALTY DAY"

In Minnesota, and I urge that every individual, school, church, organization, business establishment and household within my official jurisdiction do vigorously assume positive allegiance to our Flag and Country, through active participation in patriotic public programs sponsored by the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States and its co-sponsor on Loyalty Day, May 1, nineteen hundred and sixty-nine.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed on the State Capitol this eleventh day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine, and of the State, the one hundred eleventh.
