WHEREAS, the Life and Health Insurance Industry represents an economic flow of billions of dollars in benefits paid annually to the citizens of Minnesota,


NOW THEREFORE, I, Harold Leander, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of May 10-16, 1969, as


"LIFE AND HEALTH INSURANCE WEEK"
