WHEREAS, nearly 10,000 members participate in the activities of the more than 170 chapters located in major cities throughout the United States and Canada; and

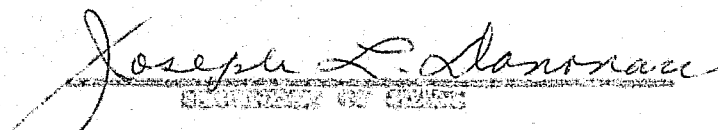

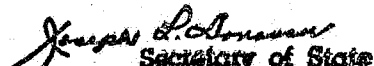
"ADMINISTRATIVE MANAGEMENT WEEK"
