


PROCLAMATION


- WHEREAS, the first Beta Sigma Phi Chapter was chartered in Abilene, Kansas, on April 20, 1931 with only seven members and is now an international organization with over 360,000 members, and
- WHEREAS, the sorority's purpose is scholarship -- cultural, service and social, with projects headed on a constituent basis in the nature of people and place, and
- WHEREAS, Beta Sigma Phi throughout the world celebrated Founder's Day each year on April 20th, 1961
- WHEREAS, the Minnesota members of Beta Sigma Phi will review their cultural, service and social projects of the past year and plan their programs for the forthcoming year at their annual state convention in Duluth, this June 4-8,
- LET THEREFORE, I, Harold Leirander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 27 through May 3, 1969, as

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to give proper recognition of the contributions made by this group to the State of Minnesota.
