


PROCLAMATION


- WHEREAS, the first Beta Sigma Psi Chapter was chartered in Abilene, Kansas, on April 30, 1931 with only seven members and is now an international organization with over 300,000 members, and
- WHEREAS, the country's purpose is threefold -- cultural, service and social, with projects handled on a continual basis on the needs of people everywhere, and
- WHEREAS, Beta Sigma Psi throughout the world celebrates Founder's Day each year on April 30th, A.M.
