WHEREAS, a family moving into a new community receives a warm welcome and cordial welcome extended by the personable members of Welcome Wagon International; this initial greeting does a great deal in encouraging a sense of community activity and involvement; and

WHEREAS, with the growth in the population of Minnesota and increasing numbers of persons and families from other states into Minnesota, the tasks of the Welcome Wagon Hostesses have increased correspondingly; and


