

PROCLAMATION


- WHEREAS, home ownership in the United States is a dream realized by more than two-thirds of our families, a record equaled by few other countries, and

- WHEREAS, by positive action, manifested most effectively through the Make America Better Program, Realtors are continuing their efforts to improve our society and maintain all levels.


NOW THEREFORE, I, Harold Lowander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 18 through 24, 1969, as
