WHEREAS, it has been the custom of the State of Minnesota for over twenty years to be represented by "Miss Minnesota" in the Miss America Pageant held annually for the selection of "Miss America," and

WHEREAS, the Miss Minnesota Pageant, for the selection of "Miss Minnesota" has been held in Austin, Minnesota, for the past four years, and

WHEREAS, the Miss Minnesota Pageant Corporation and the Austin Junior Chamber of Commerce have established the dates of June 9 through June 15, 1969, as the dates for holding the 1969 Miss Minnesota Pageant which will be held in Austin, Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, the 1969 Minnesota Legislature, by concurrent resolution, has formally recognized this annual pageant established in 1935 by designating the reigning Miss Minnesota, Miss Mary Louise Williams, and has successively selected to the future, as the official Miss Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that said pageant receive the utmost public support and recognition throughout the State of Minnesota.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of June 9-15, 1969, as

"MISS MINNESOTA WEEK"
