


PROCLAMATION


- WHEREAS Minnesota is one of America's greatest food producing states providing abundant quantities of wholesome food; and
- WHEREAS, assurance of wholesome quality foods is provided through various programs of the Minnesota Department of Agriculture and other state agencies; and
- WHEREAS, there still remains human nutritional deficiencies despite the agricultural abundance from our farms; and
- WHEREAS, changing nutritional needs throughout the cycle of life require greater family awareness of the importance of proper nutritionally balanced diets; and
- WHEREAS, the Minnesota Dietetic Association recognizes the importance of proper diet and good nutrition to the physical well being of our citizenry and supports educational activity designed to increase public understanding and awareness of the significance of good nutrition to the home, to the state, and to the nation,
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Levander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 12-18, 1969, as


"NUTRITION WEEK"
