PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, The citizens of Minnesota and the United States are acutely concerned about the threat of violence and crime in our nation, and
- WHEREAS, We are aware of the necessity of breaking the cycle which breeds crime and induces violence, and are concerned about the human misery and degradation which are products of the aforesaid crime and violence, and
- WHEREAS, Many dedicated correctional workers and interested citizens devote their services to the protection of society by aiding in the re-direction of criminal offenders into useful, productive and law-abiding lives, and
- WHEREAS, The American Correctional Association has long been the leader in developing and implementing improved programs, techniques and methods for the rehabilitation of criminal offenders, and
- WHEREAS, The American Correctional Association and its affiliates will hold the 95th Congress of Correction in Minneapolis, Minnesota, from August 17 through August 21
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Lowander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the period of August 17-21, 1969

in Minnesota, and urge that all citizens join in honoring the members of this profession.
