WHEREAS, the first day of July, 1920, marks the twentieth anniversary of the Air Force Nurse Corps, a vital organization in the United States Air Force and an essential component in the defense of the United States of America, and

WHEREAS, the Air Force Nurse Corps through these short years and throughout the world has served its country in the highest professional excellence in time of peace and in time of national emergency, and

WHEREAS, Air Force Nurses continue to carry out this mission, working in the fields of nursing, teaching and Aerospace research around the globe, in the air and on the ground, always striving for greater perfection in these fields,

BEFORE, JAMES H. HANCOCK, I, Harold Lovander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of June 29 - July 5, 1969, as

"AIR FORCE NURSE CORPS WEEK"

in Minnesota in recognition of the importance of Air Force Nurses to our national defense and our way of life, and I urge the citizens of our state to support the Air Force Nurse Corps.
