WHEREAS, the State of Minnesota will stand to reap the benefits of cooperative city-wide programs of this nature;

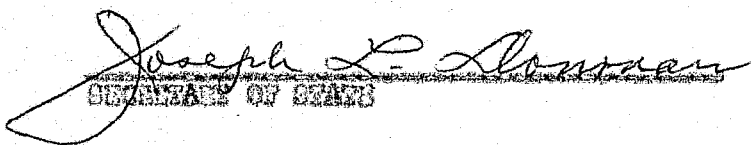
NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of August 10-16, 1969, as
