

PROCLAMATION


- WHEREAS, the Minnesota State Circle of Columbian Squires will host a Mid-Continent Conference of Columbian Squires and their Councillors at the Jesuit College, St. Bonifacius, on July 25-26-27, 1969 representing our Mid-western States and provinces of our good neighbor, the Dominion of Canada; and
- WHEREAS, on August 4, 1925, the Columbian Squires, the junior organization of the Knights of Columbus, was founded in Duluth, Minnesota; and
