WHEREAS, many collectors and representatives of Country Music and related fields will actively participate in a special observance of the progress and growth of Country Music during the month of October, 1969,


LET THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of October, 1969, as
