WHEREAS, Minnesota has been significantly honored by the selection of a native son by President Richard M. Nixon to serve in the highest judicial office in our Nation, and

WHEREAS, the installation of Warren Earl Burger as the Fifteenth Chief Justice of the United States Supreme Court is the crowning achievement ---and challenge---of his long, dedicated and outstanding career of service to his profession, his community, his state and our Nation, and

WHEREAS, all Minnesotans can be proud and grateful for such a man, eminently qualified to exercise the leadership in the highest court that must strike the correct balance between individual rights and public order, and

WHEREAS, his many friends and associates will assemble in his home city and Minnesota's Capital City of Saint Paul to give appropriate recognition to Chief Justice Warren Earl Burger at a community dinner program in his honor on August 19, 1969, and

WHEREAS, The Council of the City of Saint Paul, by official resolution, has declared that date of August 19, 1969, as "Warren E. Burger Day" in Saint Paul, and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that all Minnesotans be accorded the opportunity for sharing in this recognition for a great American

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Levander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the date of Tuesday, August 19, 1969, as

"WARREN EARL BURGER DAY"

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to appropriately participate in this demonstration of appreciation, respect and confidence due both the man and high office he now holds.
