AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES.

The Common Council of the City of Marshall do ordain as follows:

A petition has been filed with the Common Council of the City of Marshall, Minnesota, by the sole owner of the following described real estate in the County of Lyon, State of Minnesota, to have such land included within the City of Marshall, Minnesota:

All that part of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SWLWWL), and the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NWLSWL), of Section Nine (9), Township One Hundred Eleven (111) North, Range Forty-one (41) West of the Fifth (5th) Principal Meridian in Lyon County, Minnesota, described as follows:

Beginning on the west line of Section 9, Township 111 North, Range 41 West, at a point 974 feet south of the Northwest corner of the Southwest Quarter (SW1) of the Northwest Quarter (NW1) of said Section 9; thence easterly and along the south line of Nielsen's Fifth Addition and Nielsen's Sixth Addition to the City of Marshall, a distance of 1,321 feet to the east line of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SW2NW2) of said Section 9; thence southerly along the east line of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SWINWI) and the east line of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NW15W1) of said Section 9, a distance of 677 feet; thence westerly and parallel with the south lines of said Nielsen's Fifth and Sixth Additions to the west line of said Section 9; thence northerly along the west line of said Section 9, a distance of 677 feet to the place of beginning.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded and described, is 20.5 acres, more or less.

The Common Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation Section 3. will be to the best interests of the City of Marshall Minnesota and of the territory affected; and (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to city government.

Section 4. Therefore, the City of Marshall Minnesota hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in, the City of Marshall, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part hereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication.
