


That no objections, written or oral or otherwise, have been submitted to the Common Council of the City of Marshall by the town board of Fairview Township or the county board of Lyon County.

ORDINANCE NO. 406

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MARSHALL TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES.

The Common Council of the City of Marshall do ordain as follows:

Section 1. A petition has been filed with the Common Council of the City of Marshall, Minnesota, by the sole owners of the following described real estate in the County of Lyon, State of Minnesota, to have such land included within the City of Marshall, Minnesota:

All that part of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty-three (33), in Township One Hundred Twelve (112) north, of Range Forty-one (41) west of the Fifth Principal Meridian, described as follows: Beginning at a point on the west line of said Section 33, Township 112 north, Range 41 west, which is 2,035.3 feet north of the southwest corner of said Section 33; thence East 1,581.94 feet to the north-westerly right of way line of the Willmar and Sioux Falls Railroad; thence North 19 degrees 50 minutes East along said railroad right of way line to the north line of said Southwest quarter of Section 33, Township 112 north, Range 41 west; thence West and along the north line of said Southwest quarter of Section 33, Township 112 north, Range 41 west to the west line of said Section 33; and thence South along the west line of said Section 33 to the place of beginning, subject to existing easements and highways.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded and described, is 23 acres, more or less.

Section 3. The Common Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City of Marshall, Minnesota and of the territory affected; and (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to city government.

Section 4. Therefore, the City of Marshall Minnesota hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in, the City of Marshall, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part hereof.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication.
