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An Ordinance amending Section 201.3 of the Charter of the City of Saint Paul.

The Council of the City of Saint Paul Does Ordain:

SECTION 1

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 1967, Section 410.31, and upon the recommendation of the Charter Commission of the City of Saint Paul, the Charter of the City of Saint Paul is hereby amended by striking therefrom Section 201.3 in its entirety and substituting in lieu and in place thereof a new section to read as follows:

"201.3. The total cost of city government to be provided by ad valorem taxes on real and personal property in any one calendar year shall not exceed the following, viz:

The City may levy annually on each dollar of taxable property within the city, except such as is by law otherwise taxable as assessed and entered on the tax lists, a tax for general city purposes not in excess of 49.605 mills. The council may adjust the foregoing tax limitation in such amount as it may determine to be reasonably necessary to provide for tax payment delinquency. The limitation set by the mill rate heretofore set forth shall be increased by the amount of personal property replacement revenues available to the city by virtue of the provisions of Laws of Minnesota for 1967, Extra Session, Chapter 32, Article XVI (Minn. Stat. 1967, Sec. 273.69) or acts amendatory thereof.

The amount above provided for city expenditures shall be exclusive of:

a. Revenues made available to the city by virtue of the provisions of any state statute existing at the time of adoption of this charter amendment permitting the city to levy taxes in excess of or in lieu of any charter or statutory tax levy limitation or subsequent amendments to any such state statute.

b. Revenues paid directly by the state to the city, including, but not limited to, revenues received pursuant to Article V, Chapter 32, Laws of Minnesota for 1967, Extra Session (Minn. Stat. 1967, Sec. 297A.55).

c. Sums appropriated to pay principal and interest upon bonds, levy certificates or similar obligations together with expenditures made from the proceeds thereof for other than current operation and maintenance.

d. The cost of operating public utilities, parking meters, garbage or refuse collections and disposal, to the extent that the cost is met by revenues collected from patrons for the service or from other like revenues.

e. Sums appropriated for pension and retirement funds and for the Metropolitan Airports Commission.

f. The city's share of the cost of conducting the activities of the Board of Public Welfare of the County of Ramsey.

g. The cost of local improvements paid by special assessments.

Provided, however, that the city shall not be permitted to levy additional taxes by virtue of the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1967, Section 272.13, Subd. 1.

2. At least \$900,000 of the amount appropriated each year for the cost of city government shall be expended in each year in paying the city's share of the cost of street paving, construction of trunk or main sewers and bridges including right-of-way. If any part thereof be not so appropriated, it shall be used to pay interest on bonds as a part of the cost of government.

3. Out of the amounts appropriated each year for the cost of the city government and departments, at least \$250,000 shall be reserved each year and may be expended for new, replacement or renewal of departmental equipment. Any part thereof not expended in any year shall be accumulated and reserved for such use in future years."

SECTION 2

This ordinance shall become effective 90 days after passage, approval and publication, unless the effective date is delayed by the filing of a petition pursuant to law.





An Ordinance amending Section 258 of the Charter of the City of Saint Paul.

The Council of the City of Saint Paul Does Ordain:

SECTION 1
Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 1967, Section 403, and upon the recommendation of the Charter Commission of the City of Saint Paul, the Charter of the City of Saint Paul is hereby amended by striking therefrom Section 258 in its entirety and substituting in lieu and in place thereof a new section to read as follows:

"258. At the same time that the council as herein before provided shall ratify any assessment, it shall in such resolution determine and provide in what number of installments, not to exceed twenty (20) installments, the assessment against any lot, part, parcel or land shall, or may be, paid. Provided, however, that any assessment upon any lot, part or parcel of land amounting to ten dollars (\$10) or less for said lot, part or parcel shall be paid in but one payment."

SECTION 2
This ordinance shall become effective 90 days after passage, approval and publication, unless the effective date is delayed by the filing of a petition pursuant to law.

 The Council of the City of Saint Paul Does Ordain:
 SECTION 1
 Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 1967, Section 209.01 and upon the recommendation of the Charter Commission of the City of Saint Paul, the Charter of the City of Saint Paul is hereby amended by adding to Section 47 the following:
 "Nothing contained therein shall prohibit the payment of cash awards to employees pursuant to a system established by ordinance which rewards suggestions to make city operations more efficient or economical. No such cash award shall be made to any elected official, nor to any person in the unclassified service."
 SECTION 2
 This ordinance shall become effective 90 days after passage, approval and publication unless the effective date is delayed by the filing of a petition pursuant to law.
