You are therefore by these presents, appointed and commissioned CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMERCE COMMISSION as aforesaid,


TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said office of CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMERCE COMMISSION together with all the rights, powers and
