PETITION FOR INCORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF HENRIETTE.

To the Board of County Commissioners for the County of Pine,
State of Minnesota;

Your petitioners residing upon the lands hereinafter described, in the County of Pine, Minnesota, and said lands not being within the limits of any incorporated Village, and a part of the same having been platted into lots and blocks, do hereby petition your Honorables body to appoint a time and place when and where the electors actually residing upon the lands may vote for or against the incorporation of a Village of the following described lands in the County of Pine, State of Minnesota, to-wit;

The same being described as the North-west quarter (NW¹) of Section Seventeen (17), of Township Thirty nine (39), Range Twenty two (22), West. a part of which is now known as the Townsite of Henriette, Pine County, Minnesota.

That is the purpose of your petitioners to incorporate as a Village to be known and designated as the Village of Henriette, Pine County, Minnesota.

The number of persons now actually residing in the territory hereinbefore described on the 3d day of ~~January~~ ^{December}, 1919, was ~~180~~ ¹⁸⁰ as was only ascertained by a census taken under our direction on the 3d day of ~~January~~ ^{December}, 1919, as appears by the verifications annexed hereto.
