of Minneapolis, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General in the Department of Human Rights for the period commencing July 2, 1969, and to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law; and I hereby fix the compensation of said BRUCE OKNEY at the sum of Thirteen Thousand Dollars (\$13,000) per annum, to be paid from the appropriation made for the Department of Human Rights.
