AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF CROOKSTON TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES, IN AREA, ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS a certain Petition, undated, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly filed with the City Clerk of the City of Crookston; and

WHEREAS the said Petition was duly presented to the City Council of said City on the 13th day of May, 1969; and

WHEREAS the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the Petition and bounded as described, is 40 acres of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an unincorporated city, village or borough; and

WHEREAS the Petition was signed by Independent School District No. 593, which is the sole owner of said land; and

WHEREAS no objections to the annexation have been received from the town board, the county board or the governing body of any other municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS the land described in the Petition abuts upon the limits of the City of Crookston and the northeast boundary thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Crookston as follows:

SECTION 1.: The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interest of the City and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City limits and is about to become urban or suburban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

SECTION 2.: Territory Annexed: The corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:
