AFFIDAVIT OF PUBLICATION

STATE OF MINNESOTA }
COUNTY OF MAHNOMEN } SS

Wendell D. Vlasin, being duly sworn, on oath says he is and during all the times herein stated has been the publisher and printer of the newspaper known as Mahnomen Pioneer and has full knowledge of the facts herein stated as follows: (1) Said newspaper is printed in the English language in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in printed space to at least 900 square inches. (2) Said newspaper is a weekly and is distributed at least once each week. (3) Said newspaper has 50% of its news columns devoted to news of local interest to the community which it purports to serve and does not wholly duplicate any other publication and is not made up entirely of patents, plate matter and advertisements. (4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of at least 75% of its total circulation currently paid or no more than three months in arrears and has entry as second-class matter in its local post-office. (5) Said newspaper purports to serve the Village of Mahnomen in the County of Mahnomen and it has its known office of issue in the Village of Mahnomen in said county, established and open during its regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by the publisher of said newspaper or persons in his employ and subject to his direction and control during all such regular business hours and at which said newspaper is printed. (6) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State Historical Society. (7) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least two years preceding the day or dates of publication mentioned below. (8) Said newspaper has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota prior to January 1, 1966 and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State and signed by the publisher of said newspaper and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper.

He further states on oath that the printed Ordinance No. 1969-1

hereto attached as a part hereof was cut from the columns of said newspaper, and was printed and published therein in the English language, once each week, for one successive weeks; that it was first so published on Thursday the 21 day of August, 1969, and was thereafter printed and published on every.....to and including the.....day of....., 19....., and that the following is a printed copy of the lower case alphabet from A to Z, both inclusive, and is hereby acknowledged as being the size and kind of type used in the composition and publication of said notice, to wit:

ORDINANCE NO. 1969-1
AN ORDINANCE CHANGING VILLAGE
ELECTION DATES FOR THE VILLAGE
OF WAUBUN
THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VIL-
LAGE OF WAUBUN, MINNESOTA, OR-
DAINS:
SECTION 1. Pursuant to Minn. Stats.
1961, Sec. 205.07, commencing with the
1969 village election, the regular village
election of Waubun shall be held an-
nually on the first Tuesday after the
first Monday in November of each year.
SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take
effect upon its passage and publication.

August, 1969.
