ORDINANCE No. 19.08

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF BUFFALO TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES.

Section 1. A Petition having been filed with the Governing body of the Village of Buffalo, Minnesota by all of the owners in number of the following described real estate to have such land included within the Village of Buffalo, Minnesota:

That part of the North 60 acres of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 19-120-25 Wright County, Minn. described as follows: Commencing at the center of said Section 19, thence Easterly along the $\frac{1}{4}$ line 557.80 feet to the centerline of Trunk Hwy. No. 25 for a point of beg. of tract herein described; thence continuing Easterly along the $\frac{1}{4}$ line 521.7 feet; thence S-ly parallel with Trunk Highway No. 25 distant 684.7 feet to an established fence line; thence deflect right 88 degrees - 20' along said fence 521.7 feet to the centerline of said Highway; thence Northerly 682.6 feet to the point of beginning. con. 7.0 acres, more or less, and subject to the right of way of said Trunk Highway Number 25.

That part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$; Section 19, Township 120, Range 25, Wright County, Minnesota lying south of the north 1100 feet thereof and east of the centerline of Minnesota Trunk Highway Number 25 and west of the centerline of the Buffalo and Monticello Road, so-called, also known as Wright County Highway No. 114, containing 43.5 acres and subject to the right of way of said Trunk Highway Number 25 and County Highway Number 114.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description, and bounded as described, is 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres.

Section 3. The various requirements of Minnesota Statutes 414.03 having been complied with.

Section 4. The Village Council hereby determines that the annexation will be to the best interest of the Village of Buffalo, Minnesota and of the territory affected; and also hereby determines that the territory described herein abuts upon the Village and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to Village Government.

Section 5. Therefore, the Village of Buffalo, Minnesota, hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to, and included in the Village of Buffalo, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing certified copy thereof with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication.
