ORDINANCE # 54
AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE
LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF YOUNG AMERICA
TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LANDS NOT
EXCEEDING 200 ACRES°

Section 1. A petition having been filed with the governing body of the Village of Young America, by Harold Smith and Cordelia Smith, his wife, and Lowell Schrupp and Alice Schrupp, his wife, the-owners of the following described real estate, to have such lands included within the Village of Young America, Minnesota:

That part of the Northwest Quarter and of the Southwest Quarter of Section 11, Township 115 North Range 26 West, described as: Beginning at the center of Section 11, Township 115 North Range 26 West; thence North 01°45' East along the West line of Block 1, of the Village of Young America, Minnesota for 228.40 feet; thence South 86° 16' West for 140.70 feet; thence South 01°56' West for 192.60 feet; thence South 89°13' West for 193.17 feet; thence South 0.00' West for 476 feet to the Northwest corner of Lot 1, Block 1, Smith's Second Addition to the Village of Young America, Minnesota; thence North 89°13' East along the North line of said Smith's Second Addition for 333.00 feet to the West line of Smith's Addition to the Village of Young America, Minn; thence North 0°00' East along said West line of Smith's Addition for 447.50 feet to the point of beginning.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description and bounded as described is 4.26 acres.

Section 3. The Village Council hereby determines "1," that the Annexation will be to the best interest of the Village of Young America Minnesota, and of the territory affected; "2," That the territory described herein abutts upon the Village of Young America, and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to Village Government.

Section 4. Therefore, the Village of Young America, Minn., hereby ordains and declares that the property hereinbefore described be and the same is hereby annexed to and included in the Village of Young America, Minnesota, as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in force from and after filing a certified copy thereof with the Municipal Commission, the County Auditor and the Secretary of State, and from and after its passage and publication.
