The following resolution was moved by Russell Tesch, seconded by Dennis Odden and unanimously carried:

Whereas, Richard L. Jackson and Carolyn S. Jackson filed with the City Council a petition praying that the City of Madison, by ordianance declare the lands lying and being in the County of Lac qui Parle and State of Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit:

That part of Lots Ten (10) and Eleven (11) in Kjosness Addition to Madison, described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit: Commencing 196.1 feet due north of the southwest corner of Lot 11, Kjosness Addition to Madison, running thence south to the southwest corner of said Lot 11, thence east to the southeast corner of Lot 10, Kjosness Addition to Madison, thence north 199.3 feet, thence west to the place of beginning, together with the street dedicated as Eleventh Street and road right of way located between the aforesaid described property and the corporate limits of the City of Madison,

annexed to the City of Madison; and

Whereas, said real estate is within the Town of Madison, in the County of Lac qui Parle and State of Minnesota, and is a platted tract of land not exceeding 200 acres; and

Whereas, said real estate is abutting on the corporate limits of the said City of Madison and is not included in any other municipality; and

Whereas, there are no buildings on said real estate, no people residing thereon and there are no municipal improvements to the area; and

Whereas, copies of said petition have been filed with the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, the County Board of Lac qui Parle County and the Town Board of Madison Township; and

Whereas, thirty days have elapsed since the filing of said petition and the mailing of copies thereof, and no objections to the annexation to the Commission or to the City of Madison have been filed; and

Whereas, the annexation of said real estate will be to the best interests of the City of Madison and of the territory annexed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That Ordinance #170 entitled"Ordinance Annexing Adjoining Lands" be and is hereby passed and adopted and the lands described in said ordinance are hereby annexed to the City of Madison.

ORDINANCE NO. 170

ORDINANCE ANNEXING ADJOINING LANDS

The City Council of the City of Madison do ordain:

Section 1: That the following described land adjoining the limits of the City of Madison, located in the County of Lac qui Parle, State of Minnesota, is hereby added to, taken into and made a part of the City of Madison, to-wit:

> That part of Lots Ten (10) and Eleven (11) in Kjosness Addition to Madison, described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit: Commencing 196.1 feet due north of the southwest corner of Lot 11, Kjosness Addition to Madison, running thence south to the southwest corner of said Lot 11, thence east to the southeast corner of Lot 10, Kjosness Addition to Madison, thence north 199.3 feet, thence west to the place of beginning, together with the street dedicated as Eleventh Street and road right of way located between the aforesaid described property and the corporate limits of the City of Madison.

Section 2: That on the taking effect of this ordinance the corporate

limits and boundary lines of the City of Madison shall be and are hereby to include the extended westerly, northerly, and easterly boundaries of the above described

tract of land.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in full force thirty days from

and after its passage.
