AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS
OF THE CITY OF WINONA
TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED PLATTED LAND
ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated February 6, 1969,
requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly
presented to the City Council on the 6th day of February, 1969;
and

WHEREAS, the land embraced within the area described in the petition
is platted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an
incorporated city, village or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all the owners, there being only
one owner; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the
town board, the County Board, or any other governmental body; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the City of
Winona limits at the southerly boundary thereof; and

WHEREAS, copies of the said petition were filed with the Minnesota
Municipal Commission, the concerned town board, the City of Winona, and
the County Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the desirability of annexing said land has been carefully
considered,

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Winona does ordain:

Section 1. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation
will be to the best interests of the City and of the territory affected;
(2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City limits and is
urban or suburban in character; and (3) none of said territory is now in-
cluded within the limits of any city, village or borough.

Section 2. The corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to
include the platted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed
to and included within the City as effectually as if it had originally been

a part thereof:

All of Pleasant Valley Terrace - Subdivision No. 3, according to the accepted and recorded plat thereof on file and of record in Book L of Plats at page 20 in the office of the Register of Deeds, Winona County, Minnesota, except Lots One (1), Two (2) and Three (3) in Block Three (3) and Lots One (1) and Two (2) in Block One (1), and except that portion of Valleyview Drive lying southerly of a line, which line is located as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the southwest corner of Lot Two (2), Block One (1), Pleasant Valley Terrace - Subdivision No. 3; thence northerly along the west line of said Lot Two (2) a distance of twenty (20) feet to the point of beginning of the line to be described; thence in a straight line to a point where the east line of Lot Three (3) in Block Three (3), Pleasant Valley Terrace - Subdivision No. 3, intersects the south line of Circle Drive and there terminating.

Section 3. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its publication.
