- WHEREAS, the well-being of our citizens depends on the health of our economy, and
 - WHEREAS, the principle of freedom of enterprise is the basis of our economy and provides the chief impetus for its growth and stability, and
 - WHEREAS, a broader understanding of freedom of enterprise by the people of Minnesota would preserve and strengthen our free society,
- AND, WHEREAS, I, Harold L. Johnson, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of August 26-30, 1969, as

WEEK OF ENTERPRISE WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge our citizens to acquaint themselves with the principles of freedom of enterprise, and to avail themselves of the special opportunities provided during this observance by Minnans clubs in their communities.

AS WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-first day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine, and of the State, the one hundred and fifth.
