

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, September Eleventh to seventh annually has been designated National Youth Week, a movement to encourage youth, who are designated approximately one-third of our population, to improve and guide our people throughout the year in the true path for democracy and justice for all, and;

WHEREAS, there is no doubt that the work of the future will be largely in the hands of and dominated by those persons aged 25 and younger, of enlightened and educated outlook for democracy's true future;

AND, WHEREAS, I, FRANK B. ROWLAND, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim September Eleventh to seventh as

"YOUTH WEEK"

in Minnesota as it will be in this nation and throughout the world. I ask that appropriate programs of observation and participation be engaged in not only by our youth but, even more particularly, by the other half of our citizens, since over twenty-five years of age, when we ask to give honor to the youthful and forward-looking persons, the future inheritors of our democracy and the world.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-first day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-nine, and of the State, the one hundred twelfth.
