WHEREAS, it is fitting that the citizens of Minnesota recognize what the building of thousands of new houses means to civic and economic progress to the State.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Leander, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of September 14-21, as


### "INSTITUTIONAL HOME WEEK"
