WHEREAS, The people of Albert Lea and Froeborn County have received favorable notice for the work they have done in expanding job opportunities; and


WHEREAS, For the past 25 years the people of Albert Lea and Froeborn County have charted a course of community responsibility in maintaining a high level of employment; and


