AN ORDINANCE EXPENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE VILLAGE OF LINDSTROM, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNFLAFTED LAND OWNED BY THE VILLAGE ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS

UMEREAS, the Village of Lindstrom is the ewner of the Lands hereinbelow deceribed, and
