ORDINANCE NO. 95

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF
THE VILLAGE OF LINDSTROM, MINNESOTA, TO INCLUDE
CERTAIN UNPLATTED LAND OWNED BY THE VILLAGE
ABUTTING UPON THE VILLAGE LIMITS

WHEREAS, the Village of Lindstrom is the owner of the
lands hereinbelow described, and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Village of Lindstrom
wishes to declare said land annexed to the Village of Lindstrom,
and

WHEREAS, such land is urban in character and contains
approximately 24 acres, no part of which is included within the
limits of any incorporated city, village or borough, and

WHEREAS, the boundaries of no other municipality abut
upon the boundaries upon the land to be so annexed, and

WHEREAS, no petition for incorporation or annexation
is pending before the Municipal Commission including all or any
part of the land proposed to be annexed and herein described;

The Council of the Village of Lindstrom, Minnesota,
ordains:

Section 1. The Village Council hereby determines

(1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the
Village and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory
described herein abuts upon the Village limits, is owned by the
Village, is not included in any other municipality, and is urban
in character.

Section 2. Territory annexed. The corporate limits of
the Village are hereby extended to include the unplatted land
described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included

within the Village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

That certain part of Government Lot Nine (9), Section Thirty-four (34), Township Thirty-four (34), Range Twenty (20), which is described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point 16.5 feet north of the southwest corner of said Government Lot 9; thence North 89° 20' east, 982.4 feet; thence North 01° 40' West, 678.5 feet; thence North 87° 55' West, 220.0 feet; thence North 0° 17' East, 95.7 feet; thence North 32° 03' West, 429.6 feet; thence North 23° 03' West, 180.5 feet to the south line of Fairview Cemetery; thence south 86° 30' along said south line of Fairview Cemetery, 444.6 feet to the West line of Government Lot 9, Section 34; thence South along said West line, 61.0 feet; thence north 88° 30' East, parallel to the south line of Fairview Cemetery, 183.5 feet; thence South 55° 30' West, 300.6 feet; thence North 82° 00', 140.4 feet to the West line of Government Lot 9, Section 34; thence South along said West line, 578.2 feet to the point of beginning. Said parcel containing 23.99 acres more or less; together with the public street ~~thereon~~, said property on the Westerly side thereof and described as Akerson Street.

Section 3. Filing. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, and the County Auditor of the County of Chicago, Minnesota.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of certified copies as directed in Section 3.
