

CERTIFICATE

The undersigned, Judges of the Special Election for the Village of Mahnomen, Minnesota, do each and severally certify that said Special Election for the Village of Mahnomen, Minnesota was duly held at the Village Hall in said Village, on Tuesday the 6th. day of April A.D. 1920, between the hours of nine o'clock in the forenoon and five o'clock in the afternoon of the same day pursuant to a duly Published and Posted Notice to that effect, for the following purposes, Viz:

"FOR or AGAINST DETACHING" certain unplatted territory from the Village of Mahnomen, Minnesota, as prayed for in a petition to the Village Council by the property owners of said territory, the same being described as follows in said petition and in said SPECIAL VILLAGE ELECTION NOTICE: "The Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter (SE 1/4 SE 1/4) of Section Two (2) Township One hundred forty-four (144) North of Range Forty-two (42) West of the 5th. P.M.";

That there were cast at said election a total of sixty (60) votes of which thirty votes were "FOR DETACHING" and twenty-nine (29) votes were "AGAINST DETACHING" said territory from said Village and one (1) vote was held void as being improperly marked.
