Notice is hereby given that hereto attached and printed below is a copy of the proposed amendment of the City Charter of the City of St. James proposed by the Board of Free holders of said City on the 20th day of February, 1920 and delivered to the Honorable C. T. Crowley, Mayor of said City, on the 20th day of February, 1920.

That the question of adopting the proposed amendment will be submitted to the electors of said city at the General Election to be held in and for the City of St. James on Tuesday the 6th day of April, 1920; that the polls will be open from 6 o'clock a. m. to 9 o'clock p. m.

Proposed Amendment to the City Charter of the City of St. James, Minnesota by the Board of Freeholders Thereof.

Amending the sixth subdivision of paragraph 6 of Section 89 of the Charter of the City of St. James as amended September 23rd, 1919 and being that subdivision determining the limit of the indebtedness of the city, to read as follows:

The limit on the indebtedness of the city shall be the same as the

the duly qualified and acting Mayor within and for said city of St. James, do hereby certify that hereto attached is a true and correct copy of the proposed amendment to the city charter of the said city of St. James proposed by the Board of Freeholders thereof and submitted to the electors of said city at the annual city election held within and for said city on Tuesday the 6th day of April 1920.

I further certify that said amendment was duly and legally adopted by a vote of One hundred eighty-nine (189) cast in favor of the proposed amendment and a vote of 30 cast against adoption of the proposed amendment and that the total number of votes cast at said annual election was two hundred twenty-five (225).
