PROCLAMATION.

The practice begun some years ago of setting aside a special day to be known as Clean-up Day has resulted in beautifying communities and in eliminating fire causes to such an extent that the custom should be continued,

Every mayor in the State is requested to issue a proclamation to the people of his locality urging them to observe in the usual manner the day so set aside.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Joseph A.A.Burnquist, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby designate

> MAY 1. 1920 GLEAN-UP DAY

and recommend that each property owner see to it on said day that there be removed from his premises, to the greatest extent possible, all dangerous debris and thus assist in reducing fire hazards and in beautifying the community in which he lives.
