that during all the time aforesaid newspaper was a collection of general and local news, comments and miscellany literary items; and regularly issued and published on THURSDAY of each week from a known office of publication, said office being equipped with the necessary materials and skilled workmen for producing same, and has consisted of not less than four pages, of more than five columns to the page, each column not less than seventeen and three-fourth inches in length, and never made up wholly of patents or plates and advertisements. or either or any of them and has not been substantially a duplicate of any other newspaper, and has been regularly delivered each week to more than two hundred and forty paid subscribers, residing in or near the place of publication of said newspaper, and that said newspaper, composed and consisting as above set forth was printed and published in the English language weekly, and generally circulated in Wright County for more than one year preceding the date of the first publication of said notice. That the publisher of said newspaper on the 20th day of July 1907, filed with the County Auditor of said WRIGHT county an affidavit setting forth the facts required by Section 2, of Chapter 33 of the laws of the State of Minnesota for the year 1893.

VILLAGE ORDINANCE

An ordinance to extend the Corporate Limits of the village of Waverly, Wright County Minnesota.

The Village Council of the Village of Waverly, Wright County Minnesota, Do Ordain as follows:

Section 1. The west boundary line of the Village of Waverly is hereby extended so as to include within the corporate limits of said Village the following described real estate, situated and being within the County of Wright and State of Minnesota, and described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at a point on the East line of Section Five Township One Hundred Eighteen, Range Twenty Six, Two Hundred Seventy feet [270] South of the Northeast Corner of said Section Five; thence South and along said East line to the Southwest Corner of the present corporate territory of the said Village of Waverly; thence West Sixty rods to a point; thence North to the South line of the Right of Way of the Great Northern Railway; thence Eastwardly along the South line of the said Right of Way to a point thereon five rods West of the said East line of said Section Five; thence South and parallel with said East line to a point Two Hundred Seventy (270) feet south from the nearest point of the North line of said Section Five; thence East to the point of beginning.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after publication and the filing of a certified copy thereof in the Office of Secretary of State. Passed April 12th. 1920.

P E T I T I O N
TO ANNEX LAND TO VILLAGE OF WAVERLY MINN

To the President and Members of the Village Council of the Village of Waverly, Wright County, Minnesota.

Gentlemen of the Council: The undersigned petitions your honorable body and states as follows:

That he is the owner, resident upon, and in possession of the following described real property situate lying and being in the county and state above mentioned, to wit:

Beginning at a point on the east line of the northeast quarter of Section Five, Township One hundred Eighteen, Range twenty-six, 270 feet south of the northeast corner of said section Five; running thence South along said east line to the southwest corner of the Corporate territory of the said Waverly Village; thence west sixty rods to a point; thence north to the south line of the Right of Way of the Great Northern Railway; thence east along the south line of said Right of Way to a point thereon five rods west of the east line of said Section Five; thence South parallel with said east line to a point 270 feet south of the nearest point of the North line of said Section Five; thence east to the point of beginning.

Your petitioner further shows that the said described tract is adjoining to and abuts upon a portion of the west boundary line of the incorporated territory of the said Village of Waverly thru a continuous distance of Sixty three rods north and south, and that the same is agricultural land solely.

Your petitioner further shows and states that he is desirous that the said described tract be incorporated into, and become thereby a part of, the incorporate territory of the said Village of Waverly for all purposes as prescribed by law.

Wherefore your petitioner respectfully asks that your honorable body immediately take such proceedings as may be proper and necessary in the premises.
