

PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, the Civil Air Patrol, civilian auxiliary of the United States Air Force, is devoted to volunteer service to the State, the community, and the nation; and
- WHEREAS, the men and women of the Minnesota Wing of Civil Air Patrol contribute to the relief of suffering and to the aid of their fellow Americans through the performance of air and ground search and rescue and by flying humanitarian and mercy missions; and
- WHEREAS, these same civilian volunteers are promoting an effective national program of aerospace education and training for our youth; and
- WHEREAS, December 1st, 1969, marks the 20th Anniversary of the founding of this volunteer civilian organization dedicated to the service of humanity;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Levander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of December 1st, 1969, as

"CIVIL AIR PATROL WEEK"

in Minnesota, and do hereby call upon all citizens of this State to observe this week with appropriate ceremonies designed to honor the men and women of the Civil Air Patrol.
