WHEREAS, these same civilian volunteers are promoting an effective national program of aerospace education and training for our youth; and


WHEREAS, December 1st, 1969, marks the 20th anniversary of the founding of this volunteer civilian organization dedicated to the service of humanity;

WE, THEREFORE, I, Harold Leander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim this week of December 1st, 1969, as


"CIVIL AIR PATROL WEEK"


