- WHEREAS, Minnesota ranks 20th in population, 12th in size, 12th in the number of pilots, 9th in the number of aircraft, 4th in the number of publicly-owned airports; and
- WHEREAS, Minnesota has installed 32 radio-navigational and visual landing approach aids; and
- WHEREAS, The approximate total investment in aircraft and aviation facilities in Minnesota is \$260,000,000; and
- WHEREAS, Our excellent aviation facilities encourage industry to locate in Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS, The Minnesota Department of Aeronautics is dedicated to encourage, foster and assist in the development and promotion of aeronautics in the State of Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS, The Minnesota Department of Aeronautics, in cooperation with the Federal Aviation Administration, asks all pilots during this month of December to make special effort in promoting aviation safety;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Levander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of December, 1969, as

AVIATION RECOGNITION MONTH

in Minnesota.
