AFFIDAVIT OF PUBLICATION

ORDINANCE NO. 45 An Ordinance Extending the Corporate Limits of the Village of Mayer, Carver County, Minnesota to Include Certain Lands.

WHEREAS, a petition dated July 28, 1969 requesting annexation of the territory described below was duly presented to the Council on the 28th day of July, 1969:

THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MAYER CARVER COUNTY, MINNESOTA ORDAINS:

Section 1. It is hereby determined that the territory described below abuts upon the village and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government.

Section 2. The corporate limits of the village are hereby extended to include the territory described as follows:

A. C. WESSALE, being duly sworn, on oath says he is and during all times herein stated has been the publisher and printer of the newspaper known as THE WACONIA PATRIOT and has full knowledge of the facts herein stated as follows: (1) Said newspaper is printed in the English language in newspaper format and in column and sheet form equivalent in printed space to at least 900 square inches. (4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of at least 75% of its total circulation currently paid or no more than three months in arrears and has entry as second-class matter in its local post-office. (5) Said newspaper purports to serve the City of Waconia in the County of Carver and it has its known office of issue in the City of Waconia in said county, established and open during its regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by the publisher of said newspaper or persons in his employ and subject to his direction and control during all such regular business hours and at which said newspaper is printed. (6) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State Historical Society. (7) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least two years preceding the day or dates of publication mentioned below. (8) Said newspaper has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota prior to January 1, 1966 and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the Secretary of State and signed by the publisher of said newspaper and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper.
