ORDINANCE NO. 1514
AN ORDINANCE Annexing to the City of
Rochester, Minnesota, Certain Unplatted
Land in Cascade Township, Section
Thirty-Three, Township One Hundred
Seven North, Range Fourteen West,
Olmsted County, Minnesota, which is
owned by the City of Rochester, Minne-
sota.

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF ROCHESTER DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. The following described un-
platted land in Cascade Township, Sec-
tion 33, Township 107 North, Range 14
West, Olmsted County, Minnesota, is
owned by and abuts the municipal limits
of the City of Rochester:

A strip of land three hundred (300)
feet in width being one hundred fifty
(150) feet on each side of the follow-
ing described centerline:

Beginning on the east boundary of
Lot "A" Country Club Manor First
Addition at a point which is 1771.14
feet north of the south line of Section
Thirty-Three (33), Township One
Hundred Seven (107) North, Range
Fourteen (14) West, thence running
due east for a distance of 1677 feet,
more or less, measured along the
centerline, to the easterly bank of
Cascade Creek.

Section 2. The land described in Section
1 above comprising approximately 11.5
acres is hereby annexed, added to and
made a part of the City of Rochester,
Minnesota, as effectually as if they had
originally been a part thereof.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take ef-
fect and be in force from and after its
official publication and from and after
the filing of a certified copy hereof with
the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the
Cascade Town Clerk, The County Auditor
and the Secretary of State.
