

ORDINANCE NO. 16

An Ordinance changing the name of the
Village of Pelican Lakes to the Village
of Breezy Point.

The Village Council of the Village of Pelican Lakes do ordain
as follows:

Section 1. The Village Council hereby determines that 20 per cent
of the legal voters of the Village of Pelican Lakes have petitioned the
Village Council of said Village for a change of its name, and the Question
of such change of the name has been duly submitted by the Village Council
to the voters of the Village at the general election in said Village on
the 4 th. day of November, 1969, and the Village Council having duly
canvassed the votes cast on such question at said election have determined
that a majority of all votes cast upon the question are in favor of such
change.

Section 2. The name of the Village of Pelican Lakes shall be here-
by changed to the Village of Breezy Point and shall no longer be designated
as the Village of Pelican Lakes.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its pub-
lication and the filing of a certified copy thereof with the County
Auditor of Crow Wing County, the Secretary of State and the State Auditor
of the State of Minnesota as required by law.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, DOUGLAS M. HEAD, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of Minnesota Statutes, Section 8.06, and upon the request of the Commissioner of Highways, do hereby constitute and appoint

of Minneapolis, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General, and fix his compensation in the sum of Ten Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$10,500) per annum, to be paid from and out of the Trunk Highway Fund. Said Special Assistant Attorney General shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this appointment shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law. Said appointment shall take effect on October 17, 1969.
