ORDINANCE NO. 258

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ST. PETER TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED, UNPLATTED LAND CONSISTING OF 25.39 ACRES MORE OR LESS.

The Council of the City of St. Peter, Minnesota, does ordain:

Scation 1. An application for ameration has been filed with the governing body of the City of St. Peter, Minnesota, by all of the land exmers in area and number of the following described real estate to have such property included within the City of St. Peter, Minnesota:

Elects numbered respectively One (1), Two (2), Three (3), Sixteen (16), Seventeen (17) and Eighteen (18); EXCEPTING THEREFRON The North 24% feet of said Block Seventeen (17), and that portion of the Eesterly half of 7th Street and the Southerly half of Washington Avenue and the vesterly half of 6th Street abutting and adjoining said North 24%; feet of said Block Seventeen (17); all of said lands lying and being in the Torm of Traverse, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds within and for Micollet County, Winnesota.

All that part of the Southwest Cuarter of the Southeast Cuarter and all that part of the Southeast Cuarter of the Southwest Cuarter, all in Section Nine (9), Township One Hundred Ten (110) North, Range Twenty-six (26) West, which lies East of Minnesota Trunk Highway #22 described as follows:

Ecginning at the point of intersection of the Scuth line of the Scuth-east Quarter of the Scuthwest Quarter of said Scation Nine (9), with the Easterly right-of-way line of Minnesota Trunk Highway W22, said point being 377.1 feet West of the Scuth One Quarter Corner of said Section Nine (9), thence North 89°-26.5° East (assumed bearing) along the Scuth line of the Scutheast Quarter of the Scuthwest Quarter of said Section 9, 377.1 feet to the Scuth One Quarter Corner of said Section 9, thence North 80°-26.5° East along the Scuth line of the Scuthwest Quarter of the Scutheast Quarter of said Section 9, 551.14 feet, thence North 11°-08.5° West, 050.03 feet, thence Scuth 81°-37° West, 349.65 feet, thence Scuth 13°-17.3° East, 24.78 feet, thence Scuth 81°-26.3° West 706.72 feet to a point on the Easterly right-of-way line of said Minnesota Trunk Highway W22, thence Scutherly along said Easterly Highway Right-of-way line, to the point of beginning.

Excepting therefore the following described tracts:

Commoning at the point of intersection of the Easterly line of Minnesota Trunt Highway No. 22 with the South line of the Southeast Quarter of Section No. Nine (9) in Township No. One Hundred Ten (110) North of Range No. Twenty-six (26) West, and running thence East along the South line of said Section No. Nine (9) a distance of two hundred four (204') feet; and running thence in a Northwesterly direction and in a straight line to a point on the Easterly line of said Trunk Highway No. 22 and which point is distant Two Hundred and seventy-five (275) feet northwesterly from said point of commencement, and running thence

in a southeasterly direction along the Easterly line of said Trunt Highway No. 22 a distance of two hundred and seventy-five (275°) feet to the said point of commencement, which tract is the same tract as that conveyed in that corpain deed dated September 1, 1938, and filed October 5, 1938, in East 57 of Deeds, page 502. Also:

Commending at a point on the south line of Section Nine (9), Township One Mundred Ten (110), Range Twenty-six (26) West distance four hundred ten (410) feet West of the South Quarter corner thereof, run southerly at an angle of eighty-eight (88) degrees, thirty-six (36) minutes said south section line (when measured from West to South) for four hundred sixty and one-tenth (450.1) feet; thence running Ratherly along the last above described course for one hundred (100) feet; thence deflecting to the left on a ten (10) chord spiral curve of descreasing radius (spiral angle 2 degrees, 48 minutes, 45 seconds) for one hundred Sisky (150) seet; thence deslecting to the left on a three (3) degree fariy-five (45) mimste circular curve (delta Ample 52 degrees, 49 minutes, 30 seconds) for seven hundred fifty-sight & one-tenth (758.1) feet; thence deflecting to the right at ninely (90) degrees to the tangent of said curve for a distance of sirty (60) feet, the place of beginning of the track hereby conveyed, as follows; thence continuing along the last mentioned line a distance of thirty-five (35) feet; thence deflecting to the right at an apple of fifty-three (53) degrees a distance of facily-five a nine-tenth (45.9) feet, thence deficating to the right at an angle of four (4) degrees a distance of one implied trenty-five & one-tenth (125.1) feet; thence deflecting to the right at an apple of six (6) degrees, twenty (20) minutes a distance of one hundred simby-one (161) feet; thence deflecting to the right at an angle of one hundred brenty—ino (122) degrees forty (40) minutes a distance of sixty-one & five-tenths (61.5) feet; thence deflecting to the left at an angle of O degrees, turning-four & one-half (24%) minutes a distance of one hundred sistiv-four & seven tenths (164.7) feet to the easterly right-ofvay line of Minnesota Trust Highway No. 22; thenes Horthwesterly along said easterly right-of-way line a distance of but hundred simily-three & seven-tenths (263.7) feet to the place of beginning.

Also such rights and easonemis as negulard by the State of Minnesota for highway purposes.

Section 2. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description and bounded as described, conclute of 25.39 acres, more or less.

Section 3. The area proposed for execution is unplatted.

Section 4. An efficient has been filled with the City Clerk's Office stating that copies of the Petition for American have been filled with the Minnesota Municipal Counission, the Tom Board, and County Board of the Tom and County in which all or any part of the land to be ennesed is located. Note than 60 days has elapsed since said filing without objections to said ennesetion being received by the City of St. Peter.

Seption 5. The annexation will be to the best interests of the City of St. Poter.

Section 6. The corporate limits of the City of St. Peter are hereby extended to include the property described in Section 1 and the same is hereby asserted to and included within the City as effectively as if it had originally been a part thereof.

Section 7. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file extilised copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State and the Micallet County Auditor.

Section 8. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage, approval, publication and the filing of the certified capies as directed in Section 7.
