We, the undersigned, who are twenty-five or more of the votors residing within the territory horsinafter accoribed in compliance with the provisions of sections 1304 and 1305 of Chapter 9 of the General Statutes of Mannesota, for the year of 1013, and acts emendatory and supplemental to cald sections respectfully petition the Beard of County Commissioners of Polk County, Minnscote, that being the county in which the whole of caid lands horoinafter deportion are stimuted, to call an election for the determination of proposed incorporation of the territory horeinafter described to becaus the village of Nielsville, Polk County, Minnecota.
