In the Matter of the Removal of
Sol Eublick from the position of
Deputy Oil Inspector.

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR REMOVAL

I, Chris. Heen, the duly appointed, qualified and acting Dairy and Food Commissioner of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority conferred upon me by law, do hereby state that I have this day removed Sol Eublick of Duluth, St. Louis County, Minnesota, from the position of Deputy Oil Inspector, and do hereby make and file my reasons for such removal, as is provided for in Section 3635, General Statutes of Minnesota for 1913. Said Sol Eublick has been by me removed for neglect of duty, incompetency and insubordination, as specific instances of which I cite the following:

I.

That during the months of August, September, November and December, 1919, said Sol Eublick, in disobedience of orders duly given by the Chief Oil Inspector, failed and neglected to make a sufficient and proper number of inspections at retail places, within territory assigned to him, where gasoline was sold and offered for sale.

II.

Between August 1st, 1919, and January 1st, 1920, said Sol Eublick as Deputy Oil Inspector did execute

numerous inspection certificates covering gasoline and other petroleum products, which certificates so executed were in the usual manner by said Sol Bublick sent to and received by the Chief Oil Inspector at the State Capitol, St. Paul, Minnesota. That by a number of inspection certificates so executed and sent, the said Sol Bublick did falsely and deceitfully report, pretend and represent that he had at Cook, St. Louis County, Minnesota, taken samples of gasoline from tank cars and made distillation tests of the samples so taken, which cars had been shipped into Minnesota in interstate commerce from other states, and consigned to the Standard Oil Company at said Cook; whereas in truth and in fact said Sol Bublick did not at Cook, Minnesota, take samples of gasoline from such tank cars so consigned as aforesaid and thereafter make any tests whatsoever of the samples so falsely pretended to have been taken from such tank cars at said Cook.
