ORDNANCE NO. 1944 May

An Ordinance Extending the Corporate Limits of the City of Albert Lea to Include An Incorporated Territory Bounded On Three Sides By Lands Within the City Limits of Albert Lea And Abutting Thereon.

Introduced by Councilman Harlon Belcoa

WHEREAS, certain territory described below is not presently included within the Corporate Limits of any Incorporated City, Village or Borough, and

WHEREAS, this territory is surrounded on three sides by lands already included within the corporate limits of the City, and is deemed to be urban in character;

THE CITY OF ALBION IIA DOCS3 OWNIN

Sec. 1. The Corporate Limits of the City of Albert Lea are hereby extended to include the territory described as follows, which territory now is and has heretofore been surrounded on three sides by territory already included within the city limits:

Beginning at the most westerly corner of Lot 1, Block 6, Buschbom Fourth Addition to the City of Albert Lea, which point is on the southerly line of Stevens Street; thence southwesterly 323.74 feet along the most westerly line of said Lot 1, Block 6, to the most southerly corner of said Lot 1; thence southwesterly 300.12 feet on an extension of the last described line, to the southerly right-of-way line of U.S. Highway Nos. 16 & 65; thence southwesterly 492.3 feet more or less, along said right-of-way line; thence northwesterly 300.00 feet to the most easterly corner of Lot 4, Block 2, Buschbom Second Addition; thence northwesterly 319.25 feet along the most easterly line of said Lot 4, Block 2, to the most northerly corner of said Lot 4, which point is on the southerly line of Stevens Street; thence northwesterly 477.3 feet along said south line of said Stevens Street, to the point of beginning; being part of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10 T102N - R21W and containing 6.97 acres.

Sec. 2. That the above property is hereby named as C-2, General Commercial District.

Sec. 3. The City Clerk is directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Secretary of State, the County Auditor of the County of which the property is located, and the Minnesota Municipal Commission.

Sec. 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication and after filing of certified copies as directed above.

THE CITY OF ALBERT LEA DOES ORDAIN:

Sec. 1. The Corporate limits of the City of Albert Lea are hereby extended to include the territory described as follows, which territory now is and has heretofore been surrounded on three sides by territory already included within the city limits:
