The territory involved consists of the following:

Thirty-nine (39), Range Thirty-two (32)

The property is adjacent to the Village of Royalton and said lands are unplatted and used exclusively for agricultural purposes. The petition is in proper legal form and sets forth the information required in Minnesota Statutes 414.06 and upon the files and records, the Minnesota Municipal Commission being fully advised in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED: That the foregoing described real property be, and the same hereby is, detached from the Village of Royalton, and made a part of the Township of Bellevue, Morrison County, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof.
