Kiebert, Sophus Anderson and Walter Larson, the inspectors at the election held in the Village of Storden in the County of Cottonwood and state of Minnesota on the 1st of June, 1930, for the purpose of voting for or against the incorporation of the following territory, to-wit: All of the West half ($W\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southwest quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-nine (29) and the East half ($E\frac{1}{2}$) of the East half ($E\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southeast quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty (30) in Town One hundred seven (107) of Range Thirty-seven (37) in Cottonwood County, Minnesota. That the boundaries of said tract are as follows: Commencing at the Southwest corner of Section Twenty-nine (29) Town One hundred seven (107) of Range Thirty-seven (37) in Cottonwood County, Minnesota, thence east along the section line to the Right post on the south line of said Southwest quarter thence North along the Right line of said quarter to the right post on the north line of the Southwest quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Twenty-nine (29), thence east along the quarter line to the section line between section Twenty-nine (29) and Thirty (30) in said town, thence west along the east and west quarter line in section Thirty (30) to a point forty rods west of the section line between section Twenty-nine (29) and Thirty (30), thence south parallel to said section line to the section line between sections Thirty (30) and Thirty-one (31) in said town, thence east about Forty (40) rods to the point of beginning. into a village pursuant to the General Statutes of the State of Minnesota, and in pursuance of a notice duly given therefor, having been duly appointed by the Board of County commissioners of Cottonwood County, Minnesota, for that purpose, and having duly qualified as such Inspectors, do hereby certify that the said election and meeting was duly held in the Woodman Hall situated in the platted village of Storden within said territory, hereinbefore described, on said 1st day of June, 1930, being the time and place fixed in said notice.

That the polls at said election and meeting were opened at the

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hour of One o'clock P. M., and closed at the hour of Six o'clock P. M., on said day. That as such inspectors, we have duly canvassed the ballots cast at said meeting and election in the manner provided by law. That the whole number of votes cast at said meeting and election were 53. That 52 votes were cast for and in favor of the incorporation of said territory, hereinbefore described, into a Village, and having the word "Yes, on said ballots, and one votes were cast against such incorporation, and having the word "No" on said ballots. That the foregoing statements herein contained are true.



P E T I T I O N.

To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners, of Cottonwood County, Minnesota.

We, the undersigned, citizens of said county and who reside on the real estate hereinafter described, and who are actual residents and electors of said Cottonwood County do hereby petition your honorable body to appoint a time and place when and where the electors residing on said lands or real estate may vote to incorporate the territory embraced within the limits as herein described, and to be known as the Village of Storden.

Your petitioner further state that they have taken a census, within the last ten days, of the resident population or persons who reside on said lands, and that the actual number of inhabitants is Two hundred Thirty seven and your petitioners further state the land embraced within said territory and which your petitioners desire to incorporate as the Village of Storden is described as follows, to-wit:

All of the West half (W $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-nine (29) and the East half (E $\frac{1}{2}$) of the East half (E $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty (30) in Town One hundred seven (107) of Range Thirty-seven (37) in Cottonwood County, Minnesota. That the boundaries of said tract are as follows: Commencing at the Southwest corner of Section Twenty-nine (29) Town One hundred seven (107) of Range Thirty-seven (37) in Cottonwood County, Minnesota, thence east along the section line to the eight post on the south line of said Southwest Quarter thence North along the eight line of said quarter to the eight post on the north line of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Twenty-nine (29), thence west along the quarter line to the section line between section Twenty-nine (29) and Thirty (30) in said town, thence West along the east and west quarter line in section Thirty (30) to a point 40 rods west of the section line between Section Twenty-nine (29) and Thirty (30), thence south parallel to said section line to the section line between sections Thirty (30) and Thirty-one (31) in said town, thence east about Forty (40) rods to the point of beginning.

That the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section Twenty-nine (29) has been platted.

WHEREFORE, your petitioners pray that you appoint a time and place when and where the electors actually residing upon said lands as hereinbefore described may vote for or against such incorporation and that you post or cause to be posted notices of said election in three of the most public places within said territory and that you comply with such other provisions as is provided by law for the calling of said election and appoint a time and place within the limits of said proposed territory when the electors thereof may vote for or against said incorporation as provided by sections 1204 to 1208 of the General Statutes of Minnesota for 1913 as amended.

AN ORDINANCE TO EXTEND THE BOUNDRIES OF THE VILLAGE OF STORDEN AND INCORPORATE ADDITIONAL TERRITORY THEREIN.

The Village Council of the Village of Storden do ORDAIN:

Section 1. Village Boundries Extended. Pursuant to a Petition duly signed by the owner of land abutting the Village of Storden, being a tract in the East Half ($E\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southwest Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$), in Section Twenty-nine (29), Township one hundred-seven (107), Range Thirty-seven (37), in Cottonwood County, State of Minnesota, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the southeast corner stake of Lot Twelve, in Block Eight of the Village of Storden; thence running Fifty (50) feet East on the extended south line of said lot twelve; thence running north one hundred fifty (150) feet parallel with the east line of said lot twelve; thence Fifty (50) feet west to the northeast corner of said lot twelve; thence south along the east line of said lot twelve to the place of beginning;

the territorial limits of this Village are hereby extended to include the aforesaid territory within its said limits and the aforesaid land shall hereafter be a part of the Village and shall be governed as other territory of the Village is governed.

Section 2. Copy to be filed with Register of Deeds and Secretary of State.

The Village Clerk is directed to forward a certified copy of this ordinance to the Register of Deeds and the Secretary of State.

AN ORDINANCE TO EXTEND THE BOUNDRIES OF THE VILLAGE OF STORDEN
AND INCORPORATE ADDITIONAL TERRITORY THEREIN.

The Village Council of the Village of Storden do ordain:

Section 1. Village Boundries Extended. That tract of land owned by the Village of Storden, lying outside of and contiguous to and abutting on the corporate limits of said Village of Storden, in Cottonwood County, State of Minnesota, described as follows:

That part of the East Half ($E\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southwest Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) lying south of the C. St.P.M. & O. Railroad, in Section Twenty-nine (29), Township one hundred seven (107), Range Thirty-seven (37), west of the fifth P. M., excepting therefrom that portion thereof described as follows;

Beginning at the southeast corner stake of Lot Twelve, in Block Eight, of the Village of Storden; thence running Fifty feet east on the extended south line of said lot twelve; thence running one hundred-fifty feet north parallel with the east line of said lot twelve;

thence Fifty feet west to the northeast corner of said lot twelve; thence south along the east line of said lot twelve to the place of beginning;

the territorial limits of this Village are hereby extended to include the aforesaid territory within its said limits and the aforesaid land shall hereafter be a part of the Village and be governed as other territory of the village is governed.

Section 2. Copy to be filed with Register of Deeds and Secretary of State.
