Reposing especial trust and confidence in your prudence, integrity and ability I have appointed you the said CONRAD BALFOUR AS COMMISSIONER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RIGHTS, FOR A TERM EFFECTIVE JANUARY 14, 1970, AND EXPIRING THE FIRST MONDAY IN JANUARY, 1971, PURSUANT TO MINNESOTA STATUTES 363.04.

You are therefore by these presents, appointed and commissioned AS COMMISSIONER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RIGHTS as aforesaid, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said office of AS COMMISSIONER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RIGHTS together with all the rights, powers and emoluments to the said office belonging, or by law in anywise appertaining, until this commission shall be by me or other lawful authority, superseded or annulled, or expire by force or reason of any law of this State.
